Llyn Padarn Biodiversity Show - 7th June 2014

The ‘Loving our Lake’ project team is inviting families, residents, businesses and Llyn Padarn supporters in the Llanberis area to come to the ‘Llyn Padarn Biodiversity Show’ on Saturday, 7 June 2014.

“With our partners we want to offer people the chance to come and see for themselves how we are working together to look after the lake and its wildlife and what they can do to help us to protect Llyn Padarn,” says Emma Edwards-Jones, Project Manager for the ‘Loving our Lake’ project.

This free event, to be held at the Canolfan, Llanberis, between 10.30am and 2.30pm, has hands-on activities for all the family, for example;

- Attempt ‘The Drainage Challenge’ to try and build a drainage system for a village like Llanberis;
- Meet the Fish, see the beauty of Llyn Padarn’s Arctic Charr and find out what is being done to protect them;
- Visit the Llanberis Wastewater Treatment Works, an unusual opportunity perhaps, but the Works play a vital role for Llanberis, tours at 11.30am or 1pm.

“Perhaps visiting the Llanberis Wastewater Treatment Works is a rather unexpected local tour. But this is a unique chance to understand how the £2.5 million recently invested here by Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water, has been spent and is working to protect Llyn Padarn,” says Emma.

Loving our lake project was established to work with local residents and businesses to ensure that we all do what we can to protect the water quality of the lake. The ‘Llyn Padarn Biodiversity Show’ is a joint initiative by Loving our Lake, Snowdonia National Park Authority, Natural Resources Wales, Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water, Afonydd Cymru and Padarn Country Park.

Mae tîm prosiect 'Caru ein Llyn' yn gwahodd teuluoedd, preswylwyr, busnesau a chefnogwyr Llyn Padarn yn ardal Llanberis i ddod i 'Sioe Bioamrywiaeth Llyn Padarn', ddydd Sadwrn 7 Mehefin 2014.

"Gyda'n partneriaid, rydym yn dymuno cynnig cyfle i bobl gael cipolwg ar sut rydym yn gweithio gyda'n gilydd i ofalu am y llyn a'i fywyd gwylt, a beth allant wneud i'n cynorthwyo i warchod Llyn Padarn," meddai Emma Edwards-Jones, Rheolwr Prosiect 'Caru ein Llyn'.

Cynhelir y digwyddiad rhad ac am ddim hwn yng Nghanolfan Llanberis rhwng 10.30yb a 2.30yh, a chynigir gweithgareddau ymarferol i'r teulu cyfan, er enghraifft:

- Rhowch gynnig ar 'Yr Her Draenio' i geisio adeiladu system draenio ar gyfer pentref fel Llanberis;
- Dewch i gwrdd â'r Pysgod a gwerthfawrogi harddwch y Torgoch, a dysgu pa waith sy'n digwydd i'w gwarchod;
- Ymwelwch â Gwaith Trin Dŵr Gwastraff Llanberis, cyfle anghyffredin efallai, ond mae'r Gwaith yn chwarae rhan hanfodol er lles Llanberis. Bydd ymweliadau am 11.30yb neu 1yh.

"Efallai fod ymweld â Gwaith Trin Dŵr Gwastraff Llanberis yn ymweliad lleol digon annisgwyl. Ond bydd yn gyfle unigryw i ddeall sut mae'r £2.5 miliwn a fuddsoddwyd yma yn ddiweddar gan Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water wedi cael ei wario, a sut mae'n gweithio i warchod Llyn Padarn," meddai Emma.

Sefydliwyd prosiect Caru ein Llyn i weithio gyda phreswylwyr a busnesau lleol i sicrhau y byddwn yn gwneud popeth a allwn i warchod ansawdd dŵr y llyn. Mae 'Sioe Bioamrywiaeth Llyn Padarn' yn fenter ar y cyd gan Caru ein Llyn, Awdurdod Parc Cenedlaethol Eryri, Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru, Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water, Afonydd Cymru a Pharc Gwledig Padarn.
